COLOR WITH SCHOLARSHIPS

One of the most inspiring giving back stories through TPF, is of our Chairman Mustafa Kemal Abadan's. Son of two fascinating people, Mustafa Kemal Abadan dedicated his personal philanthropy to his parents. He established a scholarship fund to honor his parents by giving the gift of education, a cause his parents devoted themselves throughout their whole lives.

Mustafa Kemal Abadan's father, Yavuz Abadan was a renown professor who specialized in politics, law as well as history. Famous for his published works, he was a pioneering constitutional law professor and served as the Dean of the Political Science Faculty of Ankara University for many years. Even though he passed away in 1967, he is still remembered as a legend at Ankara University and his books are still being taught today.

His mother, Neriman Abadan Unat, widely known as "Hocaların hocası" (teacher of teachers) recently celebrated her 95th birthday. Imagine a woman who ran away from home when she was 14 years old to a country which she wasn't even speaking its native language, just to be able to go to school. That's Nermin Abadan Unat, who is famous for her determination, hard work and passion for knowledge. She dedicated her whole life to her students, her appreciated work on law and women's rights. Regardless of her age, she is still teaching at her home where her students from Bosphorus University, come once a week to be nourished by her wisdom and passion.

Inspired by his parents, Mustafa Kemal Abadan established a scholarship fund, The Abadan Awards, at Koç University, to encourage early-career scholars who are pursuing and/or completed their post-graduate studies in Turkey or abroad. The awards are administered by Koç University and alternate each year between Dr. Yavuz Abadan Constitutional Law Award for studies in constitutional law; and Dr. Nermin Abadan-Unat Social Science Award in the area of social studies with a particular focus on women's research. What a way to say "thank you for making me who I am today and inspiring me to give back."

Fatma, 26, Medical Student, Istanbul

Fatma, a medical student, traveled abroad for the first time in her life last year as a participant of Educ8 Empowerment Program. After spending a month in NYC, she discovered new horizons and started to dream big. She secured herself an internship at the Albert Einstein College of Medicine this summer. More than that, this year she donated \$150 to the program, from the funds she saved from her weekend jobs to enable others to have the same opportunity. "I used to think I would work as a doctor from 9–5 in a hospital. But now, I have bigger dreams. I want to be more than a doctor. I want to be able to make a change."



Alev & Taylan, 34-36, Young Professionals, California

Alev and Taylan, gave up their birthdays this year and asked their family, friends and colleagues to donate to a cause they wholeheartedly believe in: Education. Together, they raised over \$6,000. "If we can raise 6K in one event imagine how much we can raise together if all of our friends channel their birthday gifts towards this good cause!" They are now leading our efforts on "Giving Up Your Special Days" for causes you believe in.



Balkı, 29, Consultant, New York

Balkı established TPF's first Giving Circle. With a mission to empower women living in rural areas of Turkey, she's been fundraising since May. So far, she raised close to \$4,000. She targets to raise \$7,000 before the end of year. "I hope my Giving Circle will open the pathway to many more projects in the region to contribute to the empowerment of young women."



Damla & Anıl, 30-30, Young Professionals, New York

Our first wedding donation came from a thoughtful couple, who wanted to give more than Turkish delights to their guests at their wedding. Damla and Anıl donated to Darüşşafaka Society turning their wedding favors into education opportunities for children. "We wanted our special day to be special not just for us, but for others in need as well."



Murat, 57, Real Estate Developer/ Entrepreneur, New York

Murat who has been a supporter of TPF since its establishment, wanted to honor his late mother-in-law, who was a pioneering lawyer in the late 40s. He lead the establishment of an endowed scholarship fund in her name to make her legacy live forever. "This fund is only the beginning to share with the world how much she continues to mean to our family," he said. "There are many ways to honor your loved ones at TPF and they make the whole process very hassle free."



İrem, 45, Associate Director, Michigan

Irem grew up with a mother, Saadet Aydınsoy who was remarkable in many ways. Saadet was a brilliant engineer, true supporter of education, believer in equal opportunities and a philanthropist. After losing her mother to cancer, Irem and her family took over her mother's mission to create equal opportunities. Since then, they have been providing scholarships for girls through TPF. " Even my daughter Maya is contributing to my mother's dream. For her 7th birthday, instead of birthday presents she asked her family and friends to donate gifts to children diagnosed with cancer."



Hülya & Aydın, 60+, Entrepreneurs, Silicon Valley

Hulya and Aydin established the first Charitable Remainder Trust at TPF. They sold their home of 29 years and with part of the sale proceeds, they established a permanent fund to make their legacy live forever. "As we cherish the memories of our old house, we are happy that we got our wish - making a long-term contribution to causes of our interest in Turkey."



Alp, 45, Software Engineer, Seattle

Alp established a Donor Advised Fund at TPF to pursue his philanthropic passions. Since then, every year he grants to variety of projects and causes from his DAF. What's more is that Alp's company, which he works for matches all his donations and doubles his charitable giving. "It does not matter how much you give, but rather give routinely and make it a habit. Besides, giving money is the easiest of it all. You can give in many ways. Time, mentorship, love... There are times one might have nothing else to give, but a smile and that is enough. At TPF I get inspired by many, who demonstrate this day in and day out."



CHARITABLE BEQUESTS

A bequest in your will or trust can direct specific assets to a fund or add to an existing fund. You can reduce your taxable estate and create charitable legacy.

CHARITABLE REMAINDER TRUSTS

You can transfer cash and assets (especially appreciated assets) to an irrevocable trust and may receive income for life or a certain terms of years. The remainder passes to TPF, creating a permanent fund in your name.

CHARITABLE LEAD TRUSTS

Set up a trust that generates dividends. Throughout the term of the trust, earned dividends go to TPF. Remaining assets go to your heirs, tax-free, on the trust's appreciation.

Any retirement plan such as IRA or a 401(k) or life insurance policy allows you to create a named fund with TPF. Name TPF as the beneficiary and when you pass away, your legacy lives on through the assets transferred to TPF, reducing estate and income taxes.

REAL ESTATE AND BARGAIN SALES

You can retain the right to use your real estate during your lifetime while you receive an immediate tax deduction or can sell an asset to TPF for less than the fair market value and use the difference in value as your gift.

CHARITABLE GIFT ANNUITIES

A simple contract guarantees you a fixed income in exchange for a gift to TPF. The American Council on Gift Annuities sets annuity rates.


